Admit

Child is admitted to an IBHS program.

Diagnose

Child receives a diagnosis of either:

- Mental health
- Autism Spectrum Disorder

Assess

Clinicians complete a version of the Child and Adolescent Needs and Strengths (CANS) assessment in KIDnet.

- CANS Comprehensive (for mental health)
- CANS Autism

Treat

Clinicians address client needs and strengths identified on the CANS by using Evidence-Based Practices such as:

- Motivational Interviewing
- Trauma-Informed CBT
- Parent-Child Interaction Therapy

Collect Data

Clinicians collect data on client objectives and skill transfer in KIDnet to aid:

- Outcomes monitoring
- Future treatment planning









Repeat

The steps repeat until discharge.

Reassess

Clinicians use data to inform regular updates to the CANS assessment in KIDnet.

Treat

Clinicians continue to use Evidence-Based Practices to address client needs and strengths.

Collect Data

Clinicians continue to collect data on objectives and skill transfer in KIDnet.
















KIDnet Reports

Tracking Data from Individual Sessions Data Collection Based on a Client's Treatment Plan Objectives

Real-time graph based on data entered for specific objectives.





Average of Goal Attainment Rating scores entered on Natural Supports Skill Acquisition Data Entry Tools for a chosen cohort of individuals. An increase from the "initial" to the "last completed" represents a positive change in skill acquisition.


